

## Welcome Back to Church Worship!

### 1. Before you come back to Church

- a. Please read and understand this document thoroughly before you register to come.
- b. Complete your registration and you should receive an email confirmation. Absolutely no walk in will be allowed.
- c. Please respect your registered event GROUP time and make sure you arrive on time so there is no close contact with the next event GROUP.
- d. Please bring your own bottle of water if you have such need. No eating are allowed inside Church on Sunday morning. No food and drink will be provided by TSCAC.
- e. Sanctuary, multipurpose room and washrooms are the only areas open on Sunday morning. All other Church building area are prohibited to enter and only persons with permission can be entered.
- f. Please follow the 2 meters social distancing rule and wear a mask or face covering in the building and where necessary wear gloves.
- g. **STAY HOME IF YOU ARE NOT FEELING WELL.**

### 2. Arrival

- a. Please follow the 2 meters social distancing rule in the parking lot.
- b. All people should enter the building from main entrance only.
- c. TSCAC will open main entrance at 9:15 am (for English Worship) and 10:45 am (for Chinese Worship).
- d. If you come early, please stay in your own car and prepare your heart to worship God.
- e. If you miss your event GROUP time, please stay in your own car. You can come in after 9:25 am (for English Worship) and after 10:55 am (for Chinese Worship).

### 3. Church – Multipurpose Room

- a. Please follow the 2 meters social distancing rule.
- b. Please carry your personal belongings all the time with you. Members of GM team will remove any unknown items immediately from floor and tables.
- c. All brothers and sisters will be screened and will do temperature check when entering Church building. Please remember your temperature result and it will be required to report on the acknowledgement form (item d below).
- d. Sanitize Hands after you complete the temperature check.

- e. Complete and sign the acknowledge form. You are welcome to bring and use your own pens but please note that pens would not be allowed to be shared.
- f. Sanitize Hands before you line up to Sanctuary from main entrance.
- g. Please note that there is no fellowship any time in the multipurpose room.
- h. Please make sure you follow the instructions from ushers for seating.

#### 4. Church – Sanctuary

- a. You will be assigned a seating by ushers.
- b. There is absolutely no trading and no switching.
- c. Chairs will be arranged in a way that all chairs being used are at least 2 meters away. Please don't move any chairs out from their original positions.
- d. Please always wear mask or face covering unless exempted according to City of Toronto By-law 541-2020. You don't need to wear them only when you are serving on stage.
- e. Please do not shake hands with any brothers and sisters.
- f. The floor will be marked with "arrow" direction sign.
- g. If you need to leave Sanctuary, please follow one-way direction flows to leave and to re-enter Sanctuary.

#### 5. Church - Washroom and Kitchen

- a. Kitchen is not opened on Sunday.
- b. Maximum capacity is 2 for each washroom.
- c. Please observe the maximum number of people allowed in the washroom at any time.
- d. Proper hand washing techniques have been posted in washrooms.
- e. Designated sinks, urinals and toilet bowl have been closed to keep the appropriate 2 meters social distancing rules.

#### 6. After Worship

- a. Please stay at your seat and ushers will guide the attendees exiting the Sanctuary.
- b. Everyone will be expected to leave the Sanctuary in a safe and calm manner and keep 2 meters social distancing rules while exiting.
- c. You will depart Sanctuary using front exit only (baptism pool).
- d. Please note there is no fellowship any time inside Sanctuary and in the multipurpose room after worship.
- e. Please follow one-way direction flows to leave the building.

#### 7. Parking Lot

- a. You can meet and greet brothers and sisters in parking lot but please follow the 2 meter social distancing rule in the parking lot.
